

2013 Meeting in Istanbul, Turkey!

The Academy of International Business 2013 annual meeting had great attendance once again as we hosted over 1,200 members in Istanbul, Turkey. We extend our sincere thanks to all who worked very hard to make this a successful event. The 2013 Program Chair, Patricia McDougall-Covin (Indiana University), put together a very exciting and professionally rewarding program with the help of her track chairs (see conference program committee) and her Program Chair Assistant, Sara Reeves.

This year's program theme, "Bridging the Divide: Linking IB to Complementary Disciplines and Practice," had more than 1,425 submissions across the 12 conference tracks, coming from 79 different countries. We also had 1,454 reviewers who provided valuable input to authors and track chairs.

Some of the highlights of the program included the opening plenary, with comments from Muhtar Kent, Chairman and CEO of The Coca-Cola Company and winner of the AIB Fellows' International Executive of the Year award. Mr. Kent has deep roots in Turkey as he is the son of a Turkish diplomat and made a name for himself heading the Turkish operations of Coca-Cola at the young age of 32. The plenary also honored Bernard Ramanantsoa, head of HEC-Paris School of Management and winner of the AIB Fellows' International Educator of the Year award. Dr. Ramanantsoa has led the HEC School of Management in their strides toward a decidedly international dimension.

The AIB Fellows' Eminent Scholar award plenary honored Professor David Teece from the University of California-

Berkeley. Dr. Teece provided the keynote speech, "Dynamic Capabilities and Entrepreneurship in the Multinational Firm," and commentaries were provided by Peter Buckley, Stephen Tallman and Alain Verbeke. Pankaj Ghemawat chaired the session.

With the challenge of other academic organizations becoming more international in their membership and meetings, AIB leadership has placed special emphasis on building chapters. The AIB Chapter Chairs Workshop was limited to chapter chairs, but it is good for members to know that the chapter chairs will be working hard in the future to enhance activities and member offerings around the globe.

There were also a number of special sessions in the program. "Defining the Domain of IB: An AIB Town Hall Meeting" offered members the opportunity to discuss and debate the definition of IB's domain. Another interesting two-session panel, "Hands-On, Minds-On: Experiential Learning Projects in International Business Educations, Part 1 and 2," was devoted to learning the latest in experiential learning projects. On the final day of the conference, the 2013 JIBS Decade Award was presented to Dana Minbaeva, Torben Pedersen, Ingmar Björkman, Carl Felix Fey and Hyeon Park for their paper, "MNC Knowledge Transfer, Subsidiary Absorptive Capacity, and HRM," published in the 2003 volume of the *Journal of International Business Studies*.

The conference also included a number of networking and dining events. In particular, the Gala Event is one of the

- ⇒ **Ajeet Mathur** (IIM Ahmedabad, India) has published *IIMA Strategies for the Future: Understanding International Business* (Random House, ISBN: 978-8184000191). Have you wondered why international business seems magically simple in textbooks but inescapably complex in reality? Mathur helps you formulate assumptions and make decisions under uncertainty in response to differences in business environments, national competitiveness, and regional and global strategies of other business players. McIntyre** (Georgia Institute of Technology, USA), **Silvester Ivanaj** and **Vera Ivanaj** (Universite de Lorraine, France) have edited *Strategies for Sustainable Technologies and Innovations* (Edward Elgar Publishing, ISBN: 978-1781006825). Corporations across the world are becoming increasingly aware of the threat of environmental degradation and the growing importance of sustainable business practices. This raises a vital question: How can for-profit firms (and other profit-conscious enterprises such as government organizations) implement more environmentally friendly policies without sacrificing profitability? This innovative volume tackles that complex question, offering detailed recommendations for making strategic technological
- choices that are economically advantageous, ecologically sustainable and socially responsible.
- ⇒ **Yvonne McNulty** (Shanghai University, Singapore) and **Kerr Inkson** have published *Managing Expatriates: A Return on Investment Approach* (Business Expert Press, ISBN: 978-1606494820). Expatriation is a big topic, and is getting bigger. Over 200 million people worldwide now live and work in a country other than their country of origin. Tens of billions of dollars are spent annually by organizations that move expatriates around the world. Yet, despite the substantial costs involved, expatriation frequently results in an unsatisfactory return on investment (ROI), with little or no knowledge as to how to improve it. Why is this so? Drawing on more than a decade of expertise, research, and publications in top journals, the authors provide you real solutions to achieve more than a satisfactory ROI from expatriates—with rule number one being: Understand expatriates themselves. This book provides a practical “insider’s” guide that reveals why expatriates seek and accept international assignments; how they feel impacted by new forms of remuneration and other working conditions; how international assignments fit in with their longer-term career aspirations; and what complications arise in terms of their families. Whether you’re a manager or consultant, inside you’ll learn what modern-day global mobility is like (based on the authors’ decade-long study with nearly four hundred expatriates and their managers, as well as over a hundred who were interviewed personally), how it is changing, and why now, more than ever, a hard-nosed ROI approach is necessary.

✉ **Tiia Vissak and Maaja Vadi** (University of Tartu, Estonia) have co-edited *Dishonesty in Management: Manifestations and Consequences* (Emerald Group Publishing, ISBN 978-1781906019). This volume concentrates on different forms of honesty and dishonesty in management and their consequences for managers, firms and society. The authors conclude that the understanding of (dis)honesty and (un)ethical behavior differs in different cultural, societal and organizational contexts; moreover, it is not always easy to discover it.

Dishonesty may lead to unfavorable consequences for the dishonest and, quite often, also for the honest party, but, sometimes dishonesty may pay off for the dishonest party in the short term. This volume provides new theoretical, managerial and policy insights in the field of management research and it should interest scholars, managers and policy-makers, but also others studying or discussing these issues or having to decide if they should act dishonestly or not.
